BRET SLATER ARTIST STATEMENT

Continuing to pursue my interest in the certain physicality and objecthood of small, thick, tactile paintings, I have also begun to incorporate a distinct shift in both the scale of the work, and how the paintings are made. The change in technique or application resulted from my desire to make larger paintings; the way I go about making smaller paintings just would not work when attempted at a larger scale.

Attempts were made, and while the results were not so completely horrible, it occurred to me that they looked like jokes of themselves. (This does not apply to the "skins" which are painted on unstretched canvas & nailed directly to the wall).

The scale of the smaller work has a reason to be the scale that it is, and when larger works were made in the same way, they just simply failed to evoke what the small paintings do so well.

I still had a strong urge to make larger work, (as well as make small work) but when the scale increased, the work needed to be made in a different way, and seemed to desire to evoke something else from the viewer.

A few years ago, I gave an "Artists on Artworks" talk at the Met. I chose to stand in front of adjacent paintings by Paul Feeley & Kenneth Noland, and talk about painting. While talking, it dawned on me that the approach of these two "color-field" painters was one possible solution for me to paint bigger. I resisted attempting this approach out of respect for these painters and the specific time period these paintings were made. I thought about it over and over, debating the validity of incorporating their approach with myself for almost three years. Finally, I



was able to re-acknowledge a well-known truth i have proven to myself in the past; pure originality is an impossibility. All artwork being made today has preliminary roots in multiple forefathers and mothers. My urge to make large paintings persisted, and one solution was clear.
