"When I became a man I put away childish things, including the fear of childishness and the desire to be very grown up" C. S. Lewis, On Three Ways of Writing for Children (1976).


Undisclosed Visions and Preteen Rituals is a collection of photographic/video installations and found object sculptures. The work includes robotic upside-down Christmas trees, distorted yearbook photos, and Childcraft encyclopedias whose purpose is to recapture the unabashed wonder and confidence of pre-adolescent expression.

The loss of ignorance and ultimately innocence, whether it is through academics or life experiences, can strip away the veneer of childhood leaving self-doubt and an overcritical nature. Also lost is a way of seeing, that is unfortunately derided by adults as immature and foolish. Grown individuals may blush at the mere accusation of being called childish, and as a result reject the opportunity to express themselves in any artistic form whatsoever. To draw a stick figure is unrefined. To hum a nonsensical tune is simply beyond the pale. It is no surprise why anyone would refuse the title of artist. The word is steeped in grownup expectation.


This exhibition was created as a way to reconnect with and contemplate on that pre-educational aesthetic; one that is heavily influenced by childhood rituals and imaginative play. This is a type of expression that is in many cases not intended for an audience beyond oneself. It is free of self-censorship and full of inner exploration.

It is true, though, that one cannot go home again, and these pieces are made from the perspective of an adult looking back, not necessarily with nostalgia, but a sense of sincere appreciation.




Fade In, Fade Out #1 2016. Inkjet print under frosted glass. 25" x 1" x 34"


